- Developed and implemented Covid support package for local businesses including:
  - Providing grant support,
  - Assisting businesses with new restrictions
  - On-line promotion of businesses,
  - Virtual market place and
  - Safety signage in and around town centre
- Worked with FOG to help coordinate a Master Plan for Oswestry



- Partnered with Oswestry Town Council and Oswestry Borderland Tourism to secure £12,000 to clean town centre streets and updated town maps for visitors and local businesses
- Continued to fund a targeted cleaning programme of "eye sores" and road signage around BID Area
- Implemented security patrols around the industrial areas



- BID driving new Traffic Regulation Orders:
  - Implemented for Mile Oak with parking restrictions and line markings
  - In process for Maes-y-Clawdd to stop unauthorised overnight truck parking
  - Church Street to introduce one-way system and "calm" to area for pedestrians
  - New restrictions for Bailey Head, Bailey Street, Albion and New Street to "calm" area for pedestrians



- Developed initiative to allow local businesses to use part of Festival Square for open area food and drinks service and seating.
- Completed installation of a footfall monitoring system that includes free WiFi for town centre
- Started planning process for two "digital totems' to provide information around the town centre promoting local businesses, services and events




- Engaged consultant to develop a business directory and map for Industrial Area to improve business recognition & navigation
- Continued to commission business sector focused videos to promote the full range of retail, hospitality and business services available over the BID Area



- Submission made to 'Reverse Beeching Fund' in March 2201 with BID support and Shropshire Council providing a Letter of Support.
- Continued to run well supported training courses for Levy Payers as part on ongoing programme
